# RULES AND REGULATIONS

PLEASE WRITE CLEARLY

1. All bowlers must be listed in full name as it appears in the Yearbook.
2. Entries will not be accepted unless filled out completely.  
**NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER CLOSING DATE.**
3. You MUST bowl Doubles and Singles as a UNIT. **You can not bowl just doubles or singles.**
4. This tournament will be conducted in strict adherence to USBC rules.
5. Prize money awarded at least 1 in 8 entries. Prize money returned 100%.
6. The tournament will be conducted on a 90% handicap basis with 230 scratch except for the scratch division. Handicaps for each event will be calculated per bowler and totaled for each team.
7. Bowlers entering doubles events may change doubles teammates and compete twice. There will be no limit on placing on the doubles prize list with each new teammate. Singles entries will be limited to one place on the singles prize list.
8. Substitutions must be made no less than 30 minutes before bowling time. Multiple entry substitutions must be approved by tournament management or risk disqualification.
9. Tardy bowlers must begin in the frame being bowled with no score for any frames missed. (Rule 322a).
10. Entrants will use their highest KMBA sanctioned averages, minimum of 21 games, for the prior season as listed in the KMBA Yearbook. If no average last year, use highest current KMBA sanctioned average of 21 games or more as of first bowling date. A bowler who cannot qualify as above shall use 230. See rule 319B. Any bowler not in prior seasons KMBA Yearbook must bring a current league standing sheet showing their highest average from league play at the time of bowling in this tournament.
11. USBC rule 319D will not apply. No tournament prize winnings need be reported.
12. USBC Rule 319A.2. Ten Pins over last seasons average does apply
13. USBC Rule 319-E will be enforced. The tournament management reserves the right to rerate a bowler.
14. All entries must be members of the Kalamazoo Metro USBC BA. Non-members living within the jurisdiction of this association who are not members of another association may enter by paying an unattached membership fee (\$ 18). See Article 5, Section C. USBC Constitution.
15. Reporting of incorrect averages USBC Rule 319a – Failure to use the proper average or make a correction prior to competition of the first game of a series shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average or base prize winnings on submitted average if it is higher. If higher, then submitted average will be used.
16. Unmarried grade and high school students that have not attained the age of eighteen (18) must have written consent of their parent or guardian, one week before participation in the tournament, unless the student is accompanied by the parent or guardian, in which case the parent consent MUST be filed prior to bowling.
17. If entrant is late for doubles, his partner may bowl singles.
18. Proper bowling attire is required. Dress shorts or dress jeans are appropriate (NO CUTT OFFS). **Shirts with collars are required** in accordance with USBC tournament dress code. No Head cover will be worn during competition. **Team captains will be responsible for dress code. THIS WILL BE ENFORCED.**
19. Foul language or obscene gestures will not be allowed.
20. Bowler courtesy shall be observed. The one lane courtesy will be enforced.
21. Tournament Management will rule on anything not covered by these rules or USBC.

### Optional Scratch Divisions (Team/Singles/Doubles)

\$10 per Bowler per Event (\$9.75- Prize Fund \$ 0.25 - Expense)

1. You must enter the regular handicap event to participate in the corresponding optional scratch event.
2. You are eligible to win prizes in the handicap and optional scratch.
3. All 5 bowlers must pay the optional scratch event fee to compete in optional scratch team division.
4. Both bowlers in doubles must pay the optional scratch event fee to compete in the optional scratch doubles and MUST be the same partners as in the Handicap Event.
5. Any bowler may enter the optional scratch division in singles and All-Events, but must be competing in the corresponding handicap event.
6. At least 1 of 8 entries in each optional prize division will cash.
7. All optional Scratch Division prize money will be paid out  
(No trophies will be given for Scratch Divisions)
